Since his professional start in the 60's, he's won an Emmy for film scores, recorded 21 albums (9 solo, 2 with wife Maria, 2 with Paul Butterfield, 6 with Kweskin Jug Band and 2 with Amos Garrett) plus 8 compilations. Geoff's songs are recorded by Bob Dylan, Bonnie Raitt, Jerry Garcia, Richard Thompson, Maria Muldaur, Loudon Wainwright III, John Sebastian and scores of others. This is gonna be great!

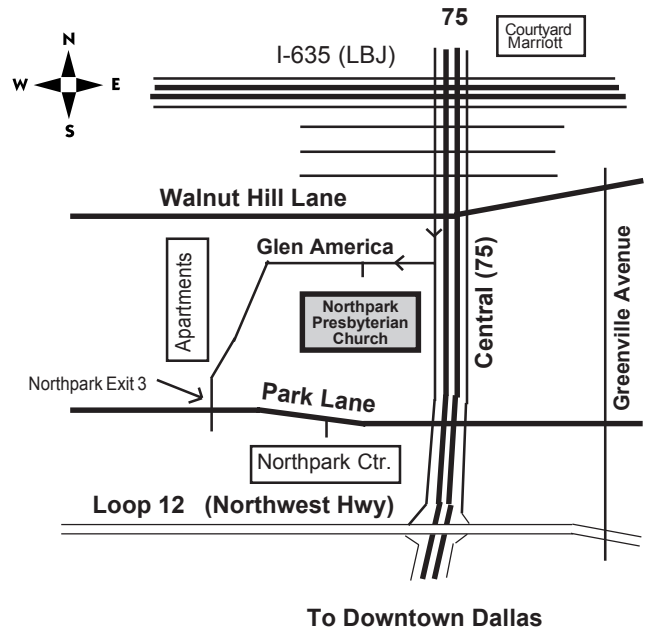
